## **HELPFUL HINTS:**

Over the years we have found the following to be very helpful:

• Standing and warmly greet attendees as they approach your vendor station – it's a great way to connect!

- Create a fun and festive setup to attract attention (Get creative, it's Christmas time!)
- Offer samples of your products to engage attendees and showcase what you offer.
- Include FREE giveaways to leave a lasting impression.
- Provide live demonstrations of your product to highlight its features and benefits.
- Dress in holiday attire or costumes to add to the festive atmosphere.
- Share your experience on social media! Post pictures or go live to build excitement and encourage attendees to join the fun.
- Don't forget to tag our social media pages and the use the hashtag **#jinglebellbazaarybor** to spread the holiday cheer!

## **WHAT TO BRING:**

- \* Bring a tent, table, and chairs for your vendor booth.
- \* Bring a pulley cart of some sort to move your products from the car to your vendor spot inside the park. The only way into the park is by walking.

### \*Vendor Spots (1-21, and 43) do not require tents. These spots are under a covered pavilion.

- \*ALL tents must have a 40lbs weights for each tent leg.
- \*ALL vendor spaces are 10x10 spaces, unless you paid for a larger size.
- \*ALL food vendors, including dessert and beverage vendors, operating inside the park must have a tarp covering the entire tent floor. Any spills that soil the grounds will result in fines being assessed.
- \*FOOD TRUCKS: Have your food license and insurance coverage always present.
- \*FOOD TRUCKS: Always have a fire extinguisher present.
- \* Bring an electric extension cord (100 ft) if you need electricity for your tent. If you have a quiet generator, recommend bringing it in case the power goes out.

## **CHECK-IN/SETUP (NON FOOD TRUCKS):**

Jingle Bell Bazaar at Ybor is held at 1800 E. 8th Avenue, Tampa, FL 33605. We have a progressive load-in process based on Zones.

\*All vendors have been pre-assigned a designated vendor spot. Please make sure you know your assigned spot number before arriving. At check-in, you will be asked for your vendor spot number and business name. Once inside the park, your vendor number will be clearly marked on the ground at your assigned location.

\* IMPORTANT: Please do not arrive before your scheduled Zone load-in time. You will not be allowed into the secured loading area until it is your zone loading time.

## **ZONE 1 (BLUE ON MAP):**

- Load-in is on 18th Street. Enter 18th Street from 8th Avenue ONLY.
- Load-in time: 9:00 a.m. 10:30 a.m. Please be fully set up by 11:45 a.m. The Bazaar begins promptly at 12:00 p.m.
- Load-in is on the park side of the street facing north.
- Please unload at the curb and move your vehicle immediately. We highly recommend bringing a pulley cart/wagon to transport your items into the park. If you arrive alone, JBBY volunteers can watch your products while you park.
- After all food trucks are set up, the streets will close and there will be no further vehicle access to the park.

# **ZONE 2 (ORANGE ON MAP):**

- Load-in is on 19th Street. Enter 19th Street from Palm Avenue ONLY.
- Load-in time: 9:00 a.m. 10:30 a.m. Please be fully set up by 11:45 a.m. The Bazaar begins promptly at 12:00 p.m.
- VENDOR SPOTS 94-100 are street vendor spots. Load-in for these vendor spots begin at 10:30 a.m. along with the food trucks in this zone.
- Load-in is on the park side of the street facing south.
- Please unload at the curb and move your vehicle immediately. We highly recommend bringing a pulley cart/wagon to transport your items into the park. If you arrive alone, JBBY volunteers can watch your products while you park.
- After all food trucks are set up, the streets will close and there will be no further vehicle access to the park.

## **ZONE 3 (YELLOW ON MAP):**

- Load-in is on 9th Avenue. Enter 9th Avenue by traveling east on Palm Avenue, turning right onto 19th Street, then turning right onto 9th Avenue.
- Load-in time: 9:00 a.m. 10:30 a.m. Please be fully set up by 11:45 a.m. The Bazaar begins promptly at 12:00 p.m.
- Yellow Zone load-in closes at 10:30 a.m. Food trucks will begin setting up in the street at 10:30 a.m., and Yellow Zone drop- offs will not be permitted after 10:30 a.m.
- Load-in is on the park side of the street facing south.
- Please unload at the curb and move your vehicle immediately. We highly recommend bringing a pulley cart/wagon to transport your items into the park. If you arrive alone, JBBY volunteers can watch your products while you park.
- After all food trucks are set up, the streets will close and there will be no further vehicle access to the park.

### **ZONE 4 (RED ON MAP):**

- Load-in is on 18th Street. Enter 18th Street from 8th Avenue ONLY.
- Load-in time: 9:30 a.m. 11:00 a.m. Please be fully set up by 11:45 a.m. The Bazaar begins promptly at 12:00 p.m.
- Load-in is on the park side of the street facing north.
- Please unload at the curb and move your vehicle immediately. We highly recommend bringing a pulley cart/wagon to transport your items into the park. If you arrive alone, JBBY volunteers can watch your products while you park.
- After all food trucks are set up, the streets will close and there will be no further vehicle access to the park.

# **FOOD TRUCKS ONLY:**

## **CHECK-IN/SETUP:**

- \*Check-in is at 10:30 am. Please be set up by 12 pm.
- Load-in is on 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Enter 9th Avenue by traveling East on Palm Avenue, turning right onto 19<sup>th</sup> Street, and turning right onto 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue.
- Please do not arrive BEFORE 10:30 a.m., as we will not be able to accommodate setup prior to that time. Non-food truck vendors will be occupying the street, leaving no space for food trucks to enter and set up until AFTER 10:30 a.m.

\*FOOD TRUCKS: Please have your food license and insurance coverage always present.

\*FOOD TRUCKS: Please always have a fire extinguisher present.

# **CHECK-OUT/BREAKDOWN:**

Please do not breakdown before 6 p.m. Loading will follow the same guidance as unloading. Please load per your assigned zone street and move your vehicles as quickly as possible to allow others to load.
